Keys to Increasing Pass Rates

Passing is dependent on three primary factors:

- 1. Completion of the study process (calendar compliance)
 - Understand the various study tools
 - Understand how to effectively use them (best practices)
 - Proper pacing to ensure completion (study calendar)
- 2. Mastery of the material (targeted study)
 - Key performance measurements (final exams versus progress exams)
 - Scores that indicate mastery
- 3. Early and actionable reporting
 - Early intervention
 - Corrective action

Student Readiness Report - Dashboard


The Student Readiness Report measures your students' pace and performance and lets your team know which students require intervention before they sit for their exam. **Helpful hint:** Use the boxes at the top of the report to filter by five key risk factors:

- 1. Total Students
- Not Started
- 3. High Risk
- 4. On Track
- 5. Low Risk

Custom Student At-Risk Auto-Delivery Report with Remediation Recommendation

- Calendar Compliance
 Student activity is not aligned to course calendar
- Targeted Study

 If student activity is aligned to course calendar, but exam scores are below 65%, suggested Targeted Study is recommended.







SPM – Reporting


The **Student Performance Manager Reports** can show all current active students by class

Select the report for format:

- Snapshot: Average scores and exams completed
- Activities: Filter on effort over a defined time frame
- Student Progress: View percentage of exams completed versus peers
- Enrollment: Review the status of current LAH and CE enrollees
- Readiness: Tracks student's pace and performance

Students can be filtered by location

The system can sort by class or search by student's last name





To create a new report or edit an existing report, click on Scheduled Reports from the report pull down menu. Your reports will be emailed to you based on your chosen interval and day.






SPM – Snapshot Report – Trending Performance

Helpful Hints:


- Click on any column and sort the values.
- Trend analysis shows whether a student's scores are improving (Green arrow = Yes, Red arrow = No)
- Average scores on Progress Exams should be >64% (these cover multiple chapters and provide early feedback as your students read the manual)
- Final Exams are comprehensive and cover the entire book. Test scores should be >70%.
- First attempt scores are an indication of how students score when they see new questions (omit scores of repeated exams)

- The Snapshot Report provides an overview of your students' performance.
- Average, scores, number of exams completed, and a trend analysis of their exam scores.



SPM Activity Report – Time Tracking Visibility

- The Activities Report allows managers to monitor their students' actions, scores, and time in exams down to the question level within a date range.
- This includes the average test score for all of the exams—Progress, Final, and Custom.
- This report is best for monitoring time in exams and time per question.




SPM – Student Progress Report


Helpful Hint:

• Managers can check First and Last Session dates, as well as number of exams and On-Demand videos completed. This allows managers to compare how students are progressing against each other.

- The Student Progress
 Report page can be used for peer comparison and to determine whether employees are on track.
- Track completion of progress exams, final exams, as well as On-Demand videos.




SPM – Student Management – Study Calendars



- Assign study calendars to students so that their pace and performance can be tracked with the Readiness Report
- Assign a start date based on a student's class or specific start date


SPM – Student Management – View All Exam Scores

SPM – Student Exam Drill Down


- View students' scores by study manual chapter

SPM – Student Exam Question Response Visibility

Sort by correct, incorrect, or all student answers. Incorrect answers are noted with red circles so that managers can easily jump to those questions.

- Our Exam modal window allows managers to see the exact questions that their students missed
- Managers can even see their incorrect answer choices



Best Practices

- Review the history report with your new hire on a weekly basis.
